**A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL.**

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale has provisions contained in Ordinance No. 283 outlining the methods and procedures for the disposal of surplus property; and

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale has such surplus property that it wishes to sell to the highest bidder.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

2. All funds received and collected from the sale of surplus properties contained in this list shall be assigned to the General Fund.
3. The sale of such items through the public bidding process shall be performed in a timely and expeditious fashion.
