DECLARING CITY OF TROUTDALE SUPPORT FOR
MULTNOMAH COUNTY SHERIFF LEVY REQUEST FOR
ADDITIONAL JAIL SPACE.

WHEREAS, Troutdale City Council believes that lack of jail space contributes to the rising crime rates in our community; and

WHEREAS, the cost of operating existing facilities is funded through operating levies; and



ADOPTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THIS 24 DAY OF OCTOBER, 1989.


