

RESOLUTION NO. 809-BR

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE THREE CITIES FIRE TASK FORCE TO COOPERATIVELY PURSUE ALTERNATIVE MEANS FOR PROVIDING FIRE SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the Cities of Fairview, Troutdale and Wood Village are part of Fire District 10 which has significantly diminished in land area served during recent years, and will eventually encompass only Fairview, Troutdale, Wood Village, Maywood Park, and the Orient area once planned annexations are complete; and

WHEREAS, the current tax rate for Fire District 10 is \$4.0193 and the projected tax rate for fiscal year 1990-91 is \$4.35 per \$1,000 assessed value, and the Cities of Fairview, Troutdale and Wood Village consider this excessive tax rate unacceptable; and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 1990 the City Councils of the Cities of Fairview, Troutdale and Wood Village directed each of their City Administrators to gather the information necessary to consider initiating withdrawal from Fire District #10; and

WHEREAS, the results of this research raised questions concerning whether all three Cities (Fairview, Troutdale and Wood Village) would be willing to commit to a joint effort in pursuing alternative means for providing fire service; and

WHEREAS, the Three Cities Fire Task Force has thoroughly considered the information gathered by the City Administrators and has concluded that the interests of the citizens of each City will best be served in the long term by continued cooperative pursuit of an alternative fire service provider, and the Task Force recommends that each City Council formally support this commitment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:




