

RESOLUTION REGARDING MEMBERSHIP IN THE CITY/COUNTY INSURANCE SERVICE TRUST PROPERTY SELF-INSURANCE POOL

WHEREAS, the City/County Insurance Services Trust (CIS) offers pooled self-insurance offering cost stability and the potential for long-term savings; and,

WHEREAS, CIS is sponsored by the League of Oregon Cities and the Association of Oregon Counties as a service to Oregon cities and counties; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale finds that membership in CIS is of benefit in managing the risks involved in providing services to its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale has been provided with an opportunity to review the Trust Agreement, Bylaws and Rules of CIS; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale has reviewed the Trust Agreement, Bylaws and Rules of CIS for compliance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Troutdale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale does hereby enter into a contract with CIS and becomes a member of the CIS Trust for Property for a three-year period commencing July 1, 1990 and agrees to abide by the terms of the Trust Agreement, Bylaws and Rules of CIS which, along with this Resolution, constitutes the contract between the City of Troutdale and CIS. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute such documents as are necessary pursuant to this Resolution.

ADOPTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THIS 10th DAY OF JULY, 1990.


