

RESOLUTION NO. 867-R

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE CITY'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT SEWAGE OUTFALL .

WHEREAS, the existing outfall which discharges into the Sandy River is not in compliance with present standards; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality requests repairs be made as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, a budgetary appropriation has been made in the Sewer Improvement Fund.

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared, construction bid advertisements published, bids opened and analyzed; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the engineer that the City award a contract in conformance with published plans and specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City Council authorize the Mayor to enter into a construction contract with the most responsible low bidder, as determined by the City Council, and that staff issue the appropriate "Notice to Proceed" upon receipt of all executed contract documents, payment bonds, performance bonds and other requirements set forth in the "Notice to Bidders", contract, bid proposal, and plans and specifications.

ADOPTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THIS 13th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1990.


