

RESOLUTION NO. 876 - R

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS SANDY RIVER STREAM EMBANKMENT STABILIZATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, portions of the Sandy River are subject to severe seasonal erosion; and

WHEREAS, this erosion is now endangering both public and private facilities; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public's health, safety and welfare to mitigate this erosion.

WHEREAS, Section 14, Flood Control Act of 1946, As Amended, provides for emergency stream bank and shoreline protection of public works and non-profit public services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

- 1) The City request that the US Army Corps of Engineers prepare a reconnaissance study to define the problem.
- 2) The US Army Corps of Engineers prepare a project feasibility study.
- 3) The City review all applicable resources for matching requirements for the construction necessary to mitigate the erosion problem.
