

RESOLUTION NO. 881-R

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXTENDING AND LOOPING WATER SERVICES ALONG HALSEY STREET.**

**WHEREAS**, a request was made for the construction of a waterline extension along Halsey Street from the Historic Columbia River Highway -- a distance of 1,400 lineal feet.

**WHEREAS**, the construction of the water main, including three fire hydrants, valves, air/vacuum release assembly, and other miscellaneous appurtenances, was found to be for public health, safety and general welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, plans and specifications were prepared, construction bid advertisements published, bids opened and analyzed; and


**WHEREAS**, it is recommended by the consulting engineer and City staff that the City award a contract in conformance with published plans and specifications.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:**

The City Council authorize the Mayor to enter into a construction contract with the most responsible low bidder, as determined by the City Council, and that staff issue the appropriate "Notice to Proceed" upon receipt of all executed contract documents, payment bonds, performance bonds and other requirements set forth in the "Notice to Bidders", contact, bid proposal, and plans and specifications.
