

RESOLUTION NO. 928-R

**RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF EIGHTH STREET RECONSTRUCTION AND ACCEPTING THE IMPROVEMENTS INTO THE CITY'S SYSTEM AS A FIXED ASSET.**

**WHEREAS**, it was found that the re-construction of the public facility was necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Troutdale entered into a construction agreement with Dirt & Aggregate Interchange, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, the construction project has been completed; and


**WHEREAS**, the City and the City's consulting engineer have inspected the project and found it to be in compliance with the plans and specifications.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:**

The project, including overlay, widening and reconstruction of approximately 1,000 lineal feet of roadway (curb, gutter, sidewalk, pavement, storm drain), for extension of Eighth Street to realign with Sandy Street, be accepted into the City's fixed asset system and any retainage be released to the contractor when the statutory holding period has expired.
