

RESOLUTION NO. 931-R

**A RESOLUTION THAT THE CITY OF TROUTDALE SUPPORTS THE ALLOCATION OF CARRYOVER FUNDS RECOMMENDATION FROM THE MULTNOMAH CABLE REGULATORY COMMISSION TO AMEND THE COMMISSION'S ADOPTED 1991-92 BUDGET.**

WHEREAS, The Multnomah County Regulatory Commission [Commission] has recommended that the member jurisdictions (Multnomah county and the Cities of Gresham, Troutdale, Fairview and Wood Village) amend the Commission's adopted 1991-92 budget; and


WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale City Council at its October 22, 1991 regular Council meeting voted unanimously to support the Commission's recommendation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:**

1. **\$20,000 be allocated for the Commission's FY 1991-92 contingency [10% of the current adopted FY 91-92 budget].**
2. **\$50,000 be added to professional services and dedicated in a Franchise Enforcement Fund.**
3. **\$159,190 be placed in pass through payments as grant funds for purchase of VCR's, monitors, mobile carts and videotape by East County school districts, enabling them to use educational programming in class curriculum.**
