

RESOLUTION NO. 950-R

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A
CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE WASTEWATER
TREATMENT PLANT MODIFICATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the construction of anaerobic digesters, a pump control building, a storage/maintenance building and other miscellaneous appurtenances, was found to be for public health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale has been awarded an Oregon Economic Development Department (Special Public Works Fund) loan for the expansion of this facility, and Council has adopted Ordinance No. 569-0 accepting the terms and conditions of the loan; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared, construction bid advertisements published, bids opened and thoroughly analyzed; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the consulting engineer and City staff that the City award a contract in conformance with published plans and specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City Council authorize the Mayor to enter into a construction contract with the most responsible low bidder, as determined by the City Council, and that staff issue the appropriate "Notice to Proceed" upon receipt of all executed contract documents, payment bonds, performance bonds and other requirements set forth in the "Notice to Bidders", contract, bid proposal, and plans and specifications.
