

**RESOLUTION NO. 959 - R**

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE MAY 19, 1992 ELECTION RESULTS FROM THE DIRECTOR OF ELECTIONS, MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON.**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 936-R called for a measure election to withdraw from Multnomah County Rural Fire Protection District No. 10 and Establish a new tax base of \$1,727,488 beginning July 1, 1992 to include Fire Protection Service to be held on the election date of May 19, 1992; and

WHEREAS, the results of the election were certified by Vicki K. Ervin, Director of Elections, Multnomah County, Oregon; and
