

RESOLUTION NO. 979

A RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM THE METRO GREENSPACES PROGRAM FOR NATURALIZING THE STORM WATER DETENTION BASIN AT THE SANDEE PALISADES SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, The City's proposed project meets all of the criteria exceptionally well for the Metro Greenspaces grant program; and

WHEREAS, The City's budget for FY 92-93 identifies funds for the project; and

WHEREAS, The detention basin naturalization project will: Improve water quality; restore the site to its natural and native state; restore the wildlife habitat; reduce management and maintenance; provide additional passive recreational opportunities and provide positive neighborhood involvement.
