WHEREAS, certain residents of Jackson Park Road have inquired as to the possibility of the City providing utility service to that area, and



The Public Works Director shall make an investigation of the aforementioned project and submit a written report to the Council as specified in Troutdale Municipal Code 12.04.030 no later than October 13, 1992.

PROCEEDING:

Resolution calling for an Engineer's Report to consider providing City water and sewer service to residents of Jackson Park Road.

BACKGROUND:

There are approximately 15 properties along the eastern side of the private portion of Jackson Park Road (south of the bridge over Beaver Creek). Most, if not all, are connected to a private water distribution system that obtains water from a spring. The remainder draw their drinking water from private wells. All use private septic systems for sanitary sewers. Recently some residents have expressed concern over the quality of the water from the spring. One or two residents who desire to sell or subdivide their property are especially concerned. An engineer's report would be the initial step in determining whether or not the City desires to provide these services.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council approve the Resolution.
