RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND IMPOSING WATER USER FEES.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 917 established water user fees effective July 1, 1991; and

WHEREAS, the City's policy is to review these fees periodically; and

WHEREAS, staff has conducted its review and submitted its report thereon; and


WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 529 provides that fees and charges shall be set by resolution.



1. Standby Fire Service requires new construction to include a "detector check" with a meter. Existing installations without these standard configurations will be billed at a rate twice that listed for standby fire service. Any consumption through detector check meters will be billed at twice the commodity charge. The rates shown are per month.
2. The rates shown are one-time charges. Installation charges for services 1-1/2" and over are billed at the cost of equipment, fittings, et cetera, plus direct labor and applicable city overhead. All installations requiring excessive pavement cuts, excessive costs, or special conditions may be billed for additional costs.
3. A stand pipe is for single family (one unit) construction use only. The rate is per 90 days or any fraction thereof.
4. Hydrant meters are to be used only for construction, agriculture or other approved short term applications. Water usage shall be charged according to the commodity charge/1000 gallon schedule.
