

RESOLUTION NO. 996-R

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDS FOR THE HISTORIC COLUMBIA RIVER HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale, Multnomah County, and the State intend to jointly fund improvements to the Historic Columbia River Highway in downtown Troutdale, and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Improvement Plan calls for several pedestrian, bicycle, historic, scenic, and beautification elements to enhance the Historic Columbia River Highway project, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 provides for funds to enhance the cultural and environmental value of the State's transportation system, and

WHEREAS, the State has called for applications for potential enhancement projects no later than November 6, 1992.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The Mayor is authorized to submit an application for Transportation Enhancement Funds for the Historic Columbia River Highway Improvement Project.
