

RESOLUTION NO. 1006

A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE METRO MULTI-FAMILY RECYCLING CONTAINER MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 1992/93.

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Service District (Metro) has been designated by the State of Oregon as the responsible jurisdiction for solid waste planning; and,

WHEREAS, the Metro Regional Plan Waste Reduction Plan requires that recycling be provided for all multi-family dwellings by June 30, 1994; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 66 requires landlords to provide recycling opportunities to their tenants; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale has agreed to work cooperatively with the cities of Gresham, Wood Village and Fairview to use Metro grant funds to place recycling containers in multi-family dwellings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:


