

RESOLUTION NO. 1008-R

RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION OF S.E. SEVENTH STREET RECONSTRUCTION AND ACCEPTING THE IMPROVEMENTS INTO THE CITY'S SYSTEM AS A FIXED ASSET.

WHEREAS, it was found that the reconstruction of S.E. Seventh Street was necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale entered into a construction agreement with Jim Keating Excavation and Grading to perform this reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, the construction project has been substantially completed; and


WHEREAS, the City and the City's consulting engineer have inspected the project and found it to be in compliance with the plans and specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:



Seventh Street reconstruction project, including widening and reconstruction of approximately 500 linear feet of roadway and associated curb, gutter, sidewalk, and storm drain, be accepted into the City's fixed asset system and any retainage (except for that necessary to ensure completion of the remaining minor work) be released to the contractor.
