A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH WASHINGTON COUNTY FOR PURCHASE OF OFFICE EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, Oregon Purchasing Law requires a bid process for certain purchases; and,

WHEREAS, ORS 190.010 provides for units of local governments to jointly enter into intergovernmental agreements for the purposes stated herein; and

WHEREAS, Washington County has complied with State bid law; and

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale wishes to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement and to participate in a purchasing contract issued by Washington County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT the Mayor is authorized to enter into and Intergovernmental Agreement with Washington County for purpose of purchasing office equipment.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into this 23 day of February, 1993, by and between Washington County Oregon, and the City of Troutdale, Oregon. This agreement will remain in full force and effect until thirty (30) days following either agency delivering written notice requesting termination upon the other agency.

WHEREAS, ORS 190.101 authorizes units of local government to enter into agreements with each other for the performance of any or all functions and activities that a party to the agreement has authority to perform; and

WHEREAS, both public agencies find it desirable to enter into this agreement in order to reduce costs of acquisition of materials and/or services which benefits both agencies;

WHEREAS, it is understood that the utilization of the contract award authorized by this agreement is elective on part of both agencies;

Therefore upon Washington County's award of a contract for steelcase furnishings (per RFP/Bid #92081B and Minute Order #92-343), the City of Troutdale may purchase under the awarded contract also; and this agreement shall only apply where consistent with the contract by Washington County to Smith Brothers Office Environment (MO# 92-343); and

Upon the City of Troutdale election to purchase under this awarded contract of Washington County, all actions for that purchase shall be the responsibility of the City of Troutdale and not Washington County; and

No fees, no transfer of personnel and no transfer of possession of or title to real or personal property is required;

All the foregoing is hereby agreed upon by both public agencies and executed by the duly authorized signatures below:
