

RESOLUTION NO. 1025

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO GRANT A RIGHT-OF-ENTRY TO THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE SANDY RIVER EMERGENCY BANK PROTECTION PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the west bank of the Sandy River just south of Interstate 84 has been eroding badly, and

**WHEREAS**, such erosion endangers the outfall line of the City's sewage treatment plant, and

**WHEREAS**, the City requested assistance from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers as authorized by Resolution 876 dated February 12, 1991, and

**WHEREAS**, the Corps of Engineers has responded to the City's request, and the two agencies entered into a Local Cooperation Agreement on March 5, 1993, as authorized by Resolution 1010 dated January 26, 1993, and

**WHEREAS**, under the terms of the Local Cooperation Agreement, the City must obtain all permits, easements and rights-of-way, and

**WHEREAS**, when the necessary permits and easements are obtained, a Right-of-Entry must then be granted to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:**

Upon receipt of required permits and easements, the Mayor is authorized to grant a Right-of-Entry to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers as described on the attached Exhibit A, which is hereby made a part hereof.

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## RIGHT-OF-ENTRY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 14 of the 1946 Flood Control Act, the United States of America under the direction of the Secretary of the Department of the Army, and the supervision of the Corps of Engineers United States Army, contemplates the construction of certain public works on the Sandy River, Troutdale, Section 14 Emergency Bank Protection, located at Sandy River, 600 feet of the left bank, south of and adjacent to Interstate Highway 84, the downstream end being at river mile 2.4.

WHEREAS, the said City has secured from the owners of all real property to be affected, grants permitting the said City and/or its assigns to occupy certain lands for the purpose of performing the construction, operation, and maintenance of said public works; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America desires written permission from said City to enter upon and use the real property aforesaid for the purpose of construction only.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City, the grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of ONE AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, does hereby permit the United States of America and/or its designated contractor, the right to enter upon and occupy all lands and premises, owned by or under the control of said City at Sandy River, Troutdale Location, in the County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, as outlined on the print of the United
