

RESOLUTION NO. 1028

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR PHASE II OF THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT MODIFICATIONS CONSISTING OF A SLUDGE STORAGE LAGOON AND ACCESS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the construction of a lined sludge storage lagoon and improvements to an access road were found to be necessary for public health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale has been awarded an Oregon Economic Development Department (Special Public Works Fund) loan for the expansion of this facility, and Council has adopted Ordinance No. 569-0 accepting the terms and conditions of the loan; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared, and the Council in Resolution No. 1021 authorized advertisement and call for construction bids; and

WHEREAS, construction bid advertisements were published, bids were received and opened, and the results have been properly analyzed; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the consulting engineer and City staff that the City award a contract in conformance with published plans and specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The Mayor is authorized to enter into a construction contract with the lowest responsible bidder, as determined by the City Council, and that staff issue the appropriate "Notice to Proceed" upon receipt of all executed contract documents, payment bonds, performance bonds and other requirements set forth in the "Notice to Bidders", contract, bid proposal, and plans and specifications.
