

RESOLUTION NO. 1034

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING EXPANSION OF THE WOOD VILLAGE CITY PARK.

WHEREAS, the City of Wood Village is pursuing expansion of their City Park by offering to purchase approximately 8.5 acres of the Multnomah County Farm property located immediately south of their existing park and within Troutdale's City limits; and

WHEREAS, the proposed property acquisition would link Wood Village's existing City Park with another 6 acre wooded parcel owned by the City of Wood Village allowing for development of an interconnecting walking trail system; and

WHEREAS, Wood Village's proposal would provide an aesthetic buffer between existing residential neighborhoods in Wood Village and future development of the Multnomah County Farm property in Troutdale; and


WHEREAS, the subject property is currently for sale and the City of Wood Village has received approval of CDBG funds for the proposed project.
