

RESOLUTION NO. 1059

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING GRESHAM TO APPLY FOR A METRO MULTI-FAMILY RECYCLING CONTAINER MATCHING GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$277 FOR FISCAL YEAR 1993/94.

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Service District has been designated by the State of Oregon as the responsible jurisdiction for solid waste planning; and,

WHEREAS, the Metro Regional Waste Reduction Plan requires that recycling be provided for all multi-family dwellings by June 30, 1995; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale has agreed to work cooperatively with the cities of Gresham, Wood Village, and Fairview to use Metro grant funds to place recycling containers in multi-family dwellings; and,


WHEREAS, in accordance with the Intergovernmental Agreement, the City of Troutdale may designate Gresham to apply for Metro recycling grant monies.

The City of Troutdale hereby designates Gresham to apply for this Metro multi-family recycling container matching grant on behalf of Troutdale for the amount of \$277.
