

RESOLUTION NO. 1076-94

**A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE CLOSURE OF EXIT 18 ON INTERSTATE 84**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Forest Service is considering several alternative locations for its proposed Gateway facility, including the Sandy River Delta area; and

**WHEREAS**, in conjunction with the proposed Gateway, the Forest Service and the Oregon Department of Transportation are also studying possible options for the future of the Jordan Road Interchange (Exit 18) on Interstate 84; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the options being considered is the closure of Exit 18, which would redirect most traffic currently using that exit to the Troutdale Interchange (Exit 17), which is already experiencing significant congestion, especially along Frontage Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the closure of Exit 18 and redirection of its traffic to Exit 17 would also greatly increase traffic volume and congestion along the Historic Columbia River Highway in downtown Troutdale; and


**WHEREAS**, the Council believes that minimizing traffic congestion is in the best interests of the residents of Troutdale and the motoring public.

The City of Troutdale opposes the closure of the Jordan Road Interchange (Exit 18) on Interstate 84.

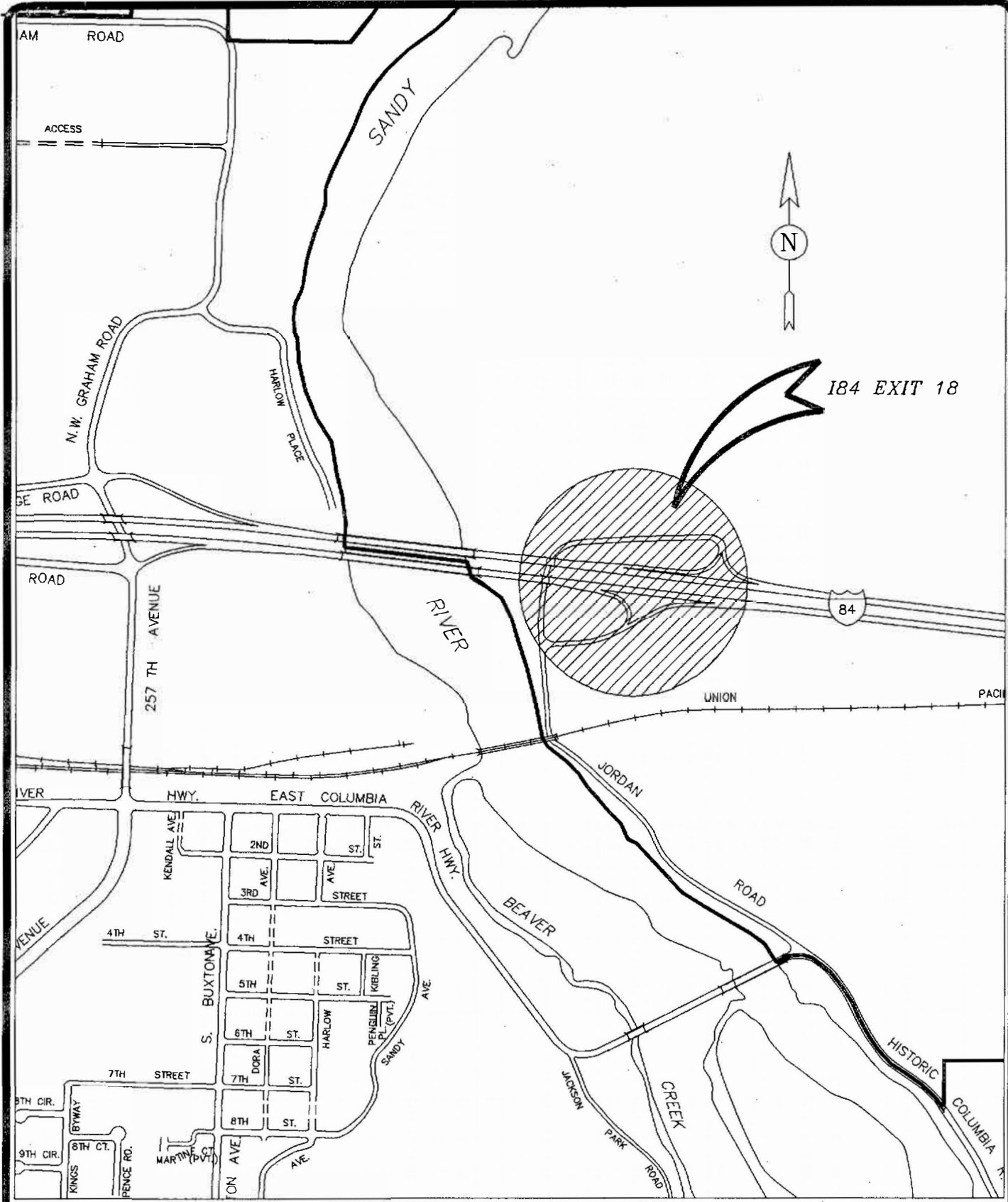
