

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A REVISED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN TROUTDALE AND GRESHAM FOR SOLID WASTE/RECYCLING SERVICES

WHEREAS, Metro has established a Regional Solid Waste Management Plan which requires local governments to adopt Annual Waste Reduction Programs; and

WHEREAS, ORS 459.017 assigns local governments the primary responsibility for planning for solid waste management; and

WHEREAS, ORS 459.065 authorizes a city to enter into any agreement it determines desirable with another government unit for joint preparation or implementation of a Solid Waste Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Gresham and Troutdale desire to enter into an agreement for joint preparation and implementation of certain aspects of a solid waste management plan, so that they may benefit from more efficient and cost effective administration by coordinating efforts to implement solid waste recycling programs of regional significance; and


WHEREAS, this agreement documents the cooperative arrangements between Gresham and Troutdale for solid waste management for fiscal year 1993-94.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to terminate the present Solid Waste Intergovernmental Agreement with Gresham and enter into a revised Intergovernmental Agreement which provides for full participation in the Solid Waste Citizens Advisory Committee.
