

RESOLUTION NO. 94-1091

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO REQUEST THAT MULTNOMAH COUNTY TRANSFER OWNERSHIP OF SW 18TH WAY (COUNTY ROAD NO. 571) FROM MULTNOMAH COUNTY TO THE CITY OF TROUTDALE.

WHEREAS, SW 18th Way (County Road No. 571) is a County road within the City of Troutdale; and

WHEREAS, ongoing construction of the Cherry Ridge Phase I subdivision will result in a residential area adjacent to the north side of SW 18th Way; and

WHEREAS, SW 18th Way is not considered an arterial road or a road of regional significance; and

WHEREAS, transfer of SW 18th Way from Multnomah County to the City of Troutdale would be in keeping with the allocation of transportation responsibilities between the County and the City; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statute 373.270 indicates that transfer of a road from a County to a City may be initiated by the County governing body upon request from the City governing body.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The Mayor is authorized to request that Multnomah County transfer ownership of SW 18th Way (County Road No. 571) from Multnomah County to the City of Troutdale and to request that the County make half street improvements to bring the street to standard.

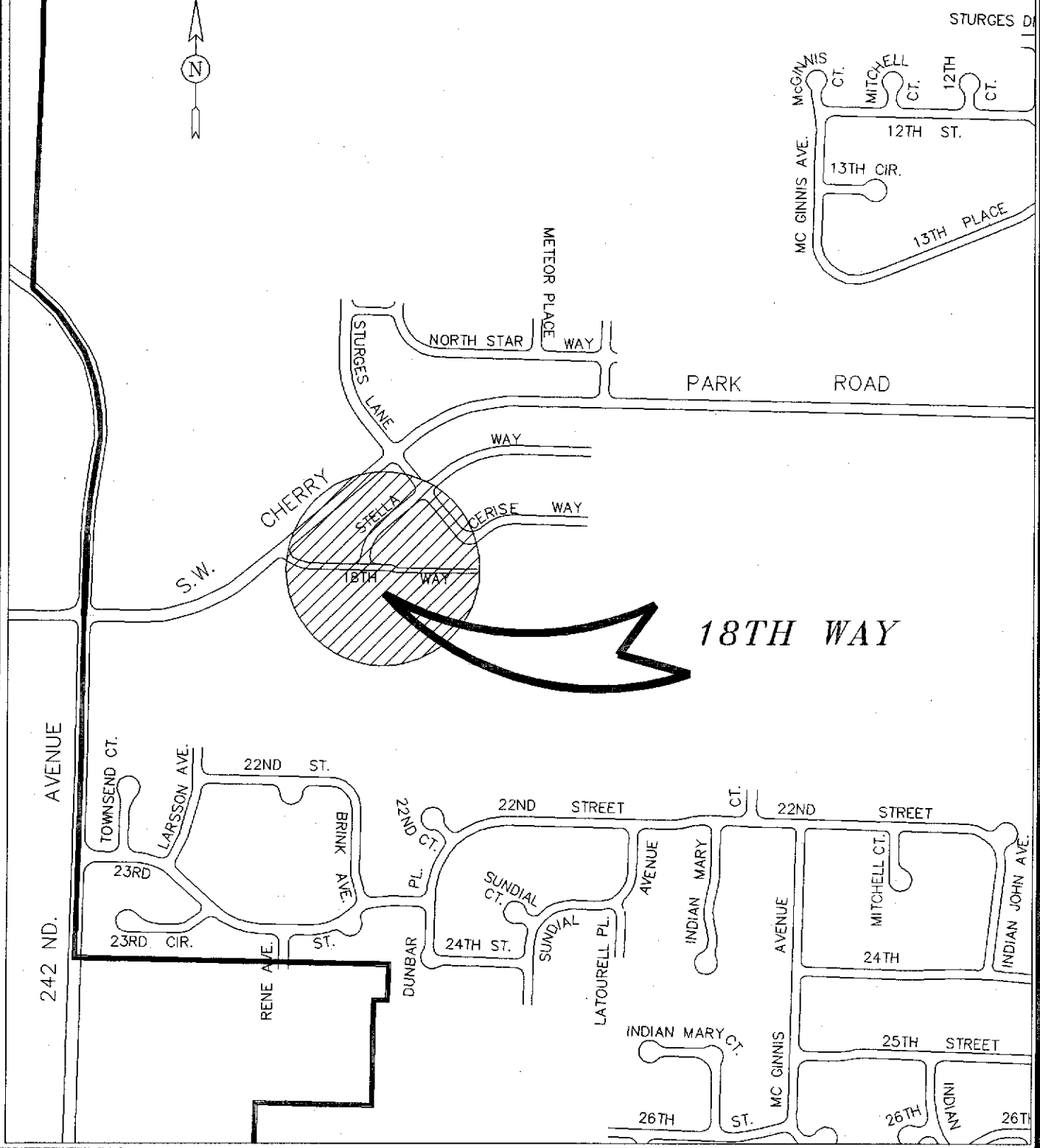
