3 **Whereas;** The study will;

- 4 1. Identify recommended standard of local preparedness.
- 5 2. Identify recommended organizational structure.
- 6 3. Identify whether current quality and levels of service will be improved.
- 7 4. Analyze whether accessibility and accountability to the public and jurisdictions
8 served will be improved.
- 9 5. Analyze whether program costs will be maintained or reduced from current levels
10 for each organization.
- 11 6. Include performance objectives and evaluation measures to assess the success of
12 the organizational structure in meeting the identified standard of care.
- 13 7. Address individual needs of the communities.
- 14 8. Present recommended option for service delivery.
- 15 9. Present recommended implementation plan and schedule.

16 **WHEREAS;** All stated statutes, charter provisions, codes and other legal mandates will be
17 followed in the formation of the recommended organizational structure, and the implementation
18 plan will be developed in consultation with counsel, and,

19 **WHEREAS;** The proposal will be in support of, not in conflict with, the overall regional goals
20 of the REMG, and,

21 **WHEREAS;** Representatives from the following governments will be responsible for developing
22 the proposal; City of Portland (Chief Bob Wall), City of Gresham (Chief Joe Parrott), and the
23 Northeast Cities (Councilor Marge Schmunk). The group will be chaired by Multnomah County
24 Commissioner, Tanya Collier, and,

25 **WHEREAS;** REMG participants, customers, employees, business and community
26 representatives, and representatives of other governmental agencies who wish to impact this
27 proposal will be consulted in this service delivery proposal, and,

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT;**


29 A proposal will be presented to the Parties no later than December 31, 1994, at which time a
30 decision will be made whether to confirm the recommended organizational structure and proceed
31 with implementation.
