

RESOLUTION NO. 1205

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO S.E. 4TH STREET (BETWEEN BUXTON AND S.E. SANDY AVENUE), S.E. 2ND STREET (BETWEEN BUXTON AND S.E. DORA AVENUE), S.E. DORA AVENUE (BETWEEN 2ND & 3RD STREETS), AND S.W. MARTINE COURT AND ACCEPTING THEM INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, it was found that the reconstruction of portions of the aforesaid downtown streets was necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale entered into a construction agreement with Wubben Brothers Construction to perform these improvements; and

WHEREAS, all construction projects have been completed; and

WHEREAS, City staff and the City's consulting engineer have inspected all projects and all were found to be in accordance with the Troutdale City standards and plans and specifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

That the following portions of street improvements be accepted into the City's fixed asset system:

S.E. Dora Avenue, between S.E. 2nd Street and S. E. 3rd Street, valued at \$ 41,245.83. This included widening the street, and reconstruction of approximately 300 feet of road way and associated curbs, gutters, sidewalks and storm drainage facilities.

S.E. 2nd Street, between Buxton Avenue and S.E. Dora Avenue, valued at \$ 66,604.22. This included widening the street, and reconstruction of approximately 300 feet of road way and associated curbs, gutters, sidewalks, retaining walls and storm drainage facilities.

S.E. 4th Street, between Buxton and Sandy Avenue, valued at \$ 210,107.36. This included widening the street, and reconstruction of approximately 950 feet of road way and associated curbs, gutters, sidewalks, retaining walls and storm drainage facilities.

S.W. Martine Court, from Buxton to its end, valued at \$ 81,597.67. This included widening the street, and reconstruction of approximately 300 feet of road way and associated curbs, gutters, sidewalks, storm drainage facilities, and undergrounding overhead utility lines.
