PARK TO GLENN OTTO COMMUNITY PARK**

WHEREAS, the late Glenn Otto served the City of Troutdale for many years as a Planning Commissioner, City Councilor and Mayor; and,


WHEREAS, in addition to his service to the City, Glenn Otto served 12 years in the Oregon House of Representatives and 8 years in the Oregon Senate before retiring in 1993; and,

WHEREAS, during his tenure of service to the City of Troutdale he single-handedly negotiated a bargain purchase of Troutdale's first park site located along the banks of the Sandy River and provided the leadership in the creation and improvement of the park; and,

WHEREAS, the people of Troutdale wish to honor Glenn Otto's illustrious career of devoted service to the City of Troutdale and his vision and leadership in acquiring and developing the riverside park site now known as Troutdale Community Park; now, therefore,
