

RESOLUTION NO. 1255

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE ELECTION OF THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL POSITIONS WITH TERMS EXPIRING THE FIRST REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING OF 1997.


WHEREAS, the terms of office for the Mayor, Council Position #2, Council Position #4, and Council Position #6 expire at the first Regular Council Meeting of 1997, and,

WHEREAS, Council Position #5 was vacated by resignation, and filled through appointment, with the term to expire at the first Regular Council Meeting of 1997;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

1. Election for the office of the Mayor and four City Council positions shall be held on the regular general election date of November 5, 1996.
2. The term of office for the Mayor, Council Position #2, Council Position #4, and Council Position #6, filled by the general election of November 5, 1996, shall expire at the first Regular Council Meeting of 2001.
3. The term of office for Council Position #5, filled by the general election of November 5, 1996, shall expire at the first Regular Council Meeting of 1999.
4. All candidates for the office of the Mayor or a City Council position shall file, with the Elections Officer at Troutdale City Hall, a petition for office with signatures of at least 25 qualified electors of the City of Troutdale no sooner than 8:00 a.m. August 7, and no later than 5:00 p.m. August 22, 1996.
5. The prospective petition shall identify the name of the candidate, the office or position number, and the election date. The petition shall also include the name, address, and signature of the petitioner.
6. The City Elections Officer will have available 1996 City Election Manuals and Forms at no charge to qualified electors.
