

RESOLUTION NO. 1262

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING DECLARATION FOR THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AS A TREE CITY USA.

WHEREAS, the citizens of Troutdale benefit from a large number of trees consisting both of natural growth and those planted throughout the years; and

WHEREAS, the retention of trees and wooded areas in the city add to the livability of the community by enhancing its aesthetic beauty, minimizing surface water and ground water run-off and diversion, filtering noise and air pollution, and promoting soil stability; and

WHEREAS, the city is desirous of obtaining status as a Tree City USA; and

WHEREAS, the city currently satisfies most of the criteria to become a Tree City USA;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The Parks and Facilities Division is authorized to apply for Tree City USA status; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

The Troutdale Citizen Advisory Committee be designated as the city's tree board for the purposes of satisfying requirements for such status.
