

RESOLUTION NO. 1269

**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE
BEAVER CREEK SANITARY SEWER PUMP STATION
IMPROVEMENTS AND ACCEPTING THEM INTO THE
CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM.**

WHEREAS, it was found that improvements to these public facilities were necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, these improvements were also necessary to meet the demands from all new construction the City has experienced; and

WHEREAS, these improvements consist of two new larger capacity sanitary sewer pumps, a new wet well for storage, a new oversized sanitary sewer manhole, a generator building, a backup electric generator and all required electrical and incidental mechanical controls required to make these improvements work properly; and,

WHEREAS, improvements were inspected by City staff and the engineering firm hired to design this project; and

WHEREAS, all improvements were found to be in accordance with the Troutdale City Standards, construction plans and specifications; and

WHEREAS, the construction of these public improvements has been completed.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TROUTDALE**

That these public improvements made to the Beaver Creek sanitary sewer pump station, valued at \$ 295,553.52, be accepted into the City's fixed asset system.

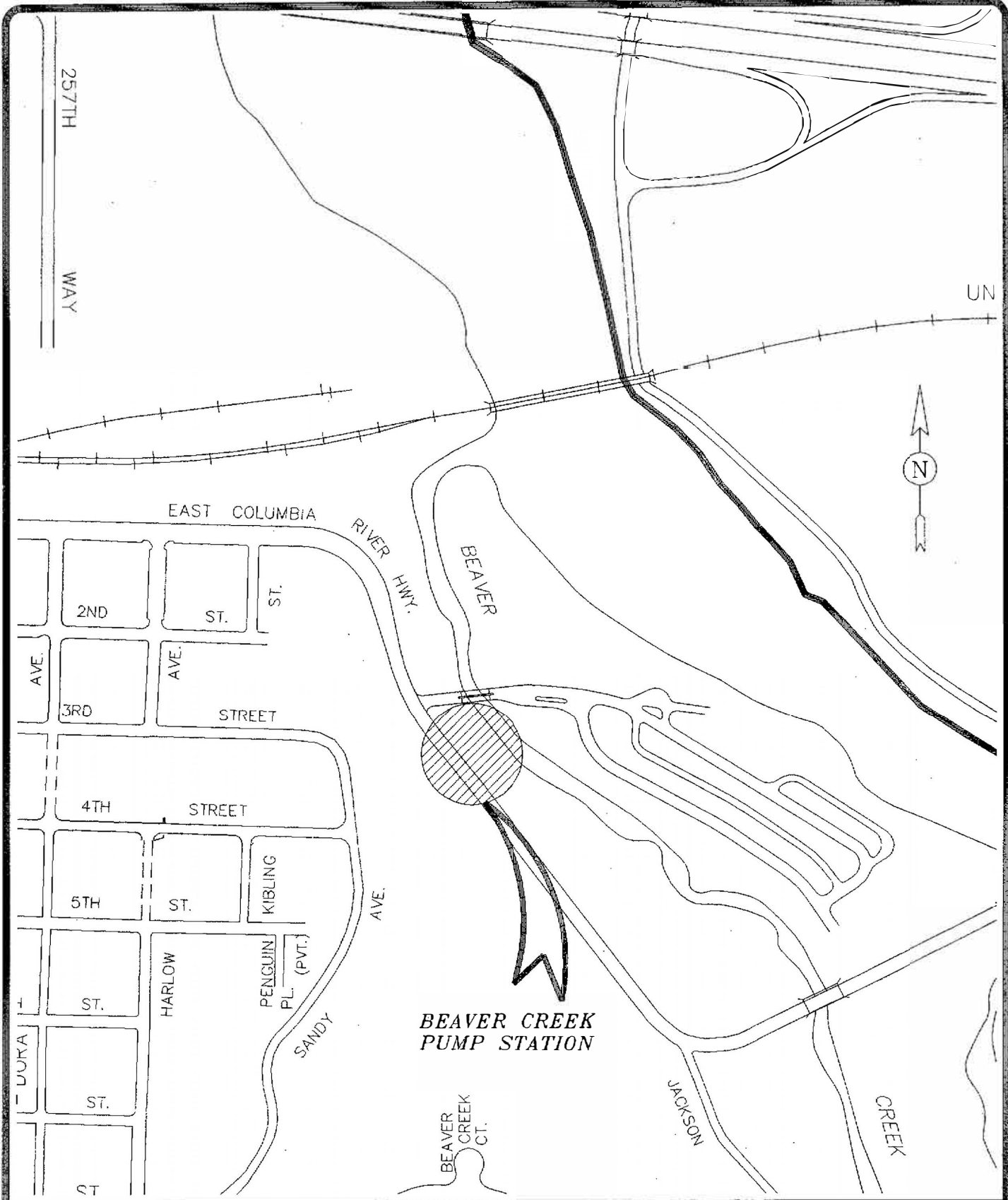
