

RESOLUTION NO. 1280

**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE
257TH AVENUE PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE (PRV) AND
VAULT UPSIZING AND ACCEPTING IT INTO THE CITY'S
FIXED ASSET SYSTEM.**

WHEREAS, it was found that these improvements were necessary to meet the demands of the public's health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, these improvements to the water distribution system were necessary to adequately serve the north portion of the City during the temporary shut down of the PRV by the railroad bridge over I-84; and

WHEREAS, these system improvements were designed by Crane & Merseth Engineering/Surveying, and constructed by W.G. Moe & Sons Construction; and

WHEREAS, City staff inspected these improvements during and after construction and found them to be in accordance with the plans and specifications.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TROUTDALE**

That the 257th Avenue PRV improvements to the water distribution system, valued at \$30,752.49, are accepted into the City's fixed asset system.

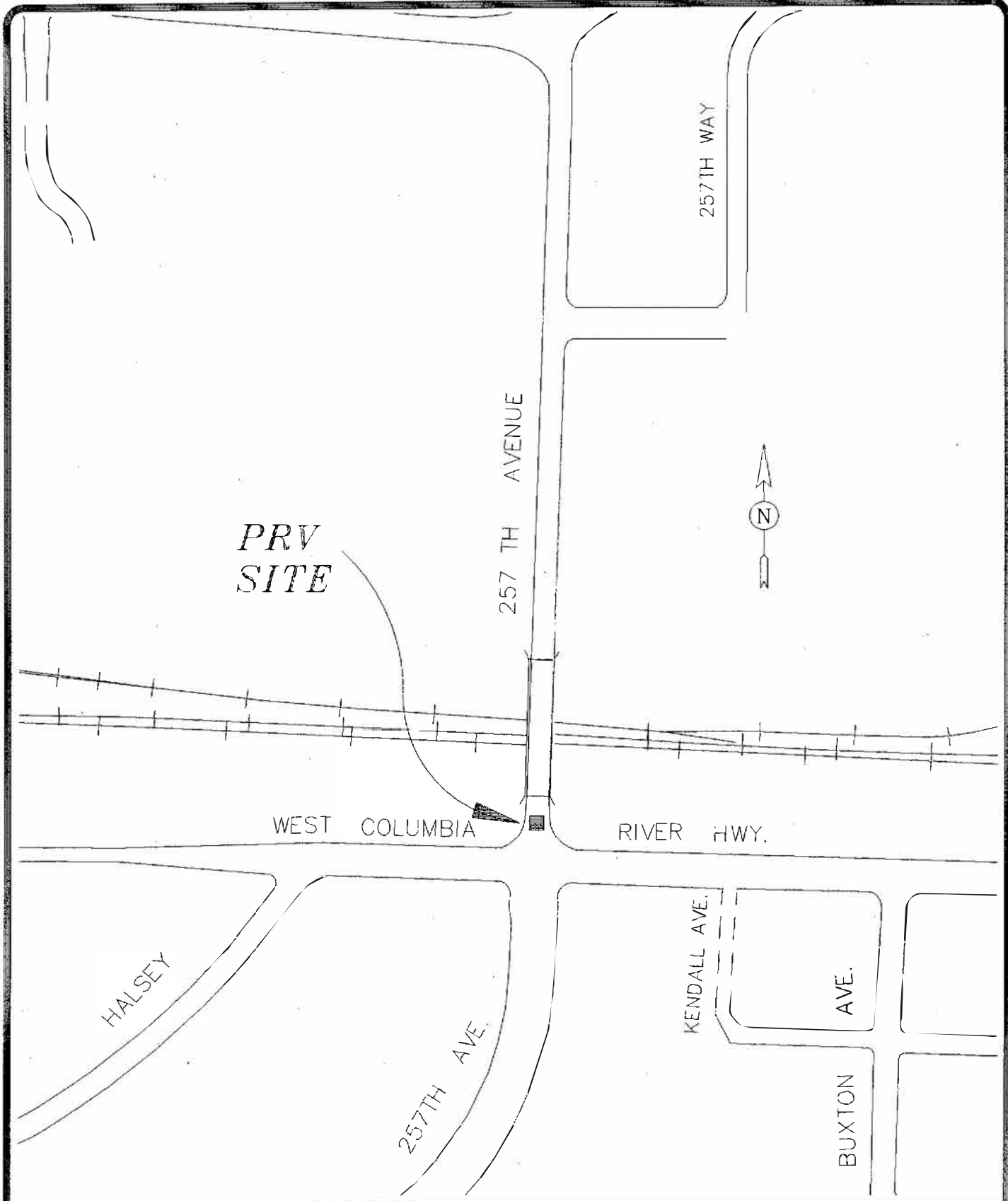
