

RESOLUTION NO. 1281

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE PUBLIC WORKS FACILITIES IN THE HAMPTON POINT PHASE II SUBDIVISION AND ACCEPTING THEM INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM.

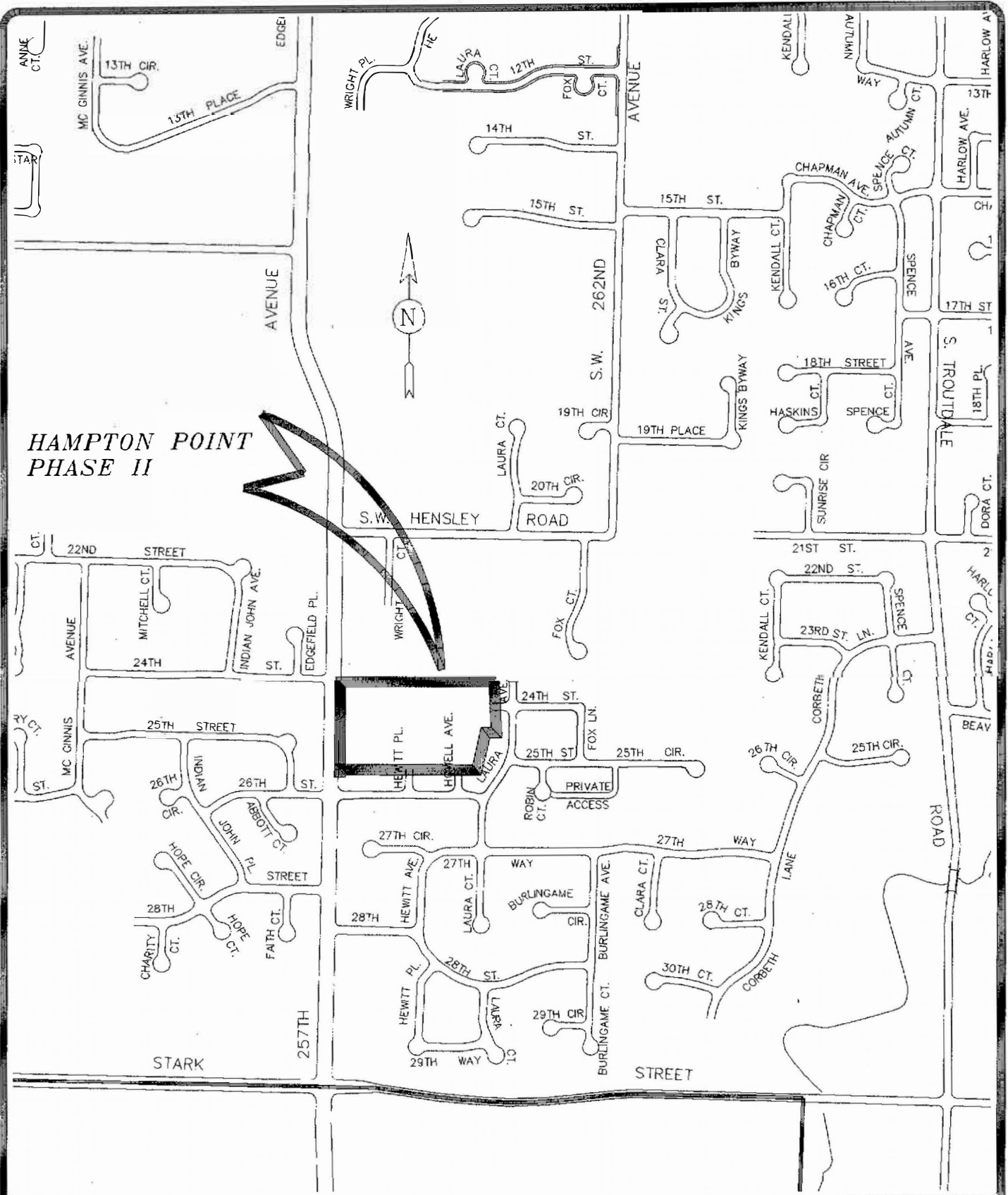
