A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE PUBLIC WORKS FACILITIES IN THE SEDONA PARK SUBDIVISION AND ACCEPTING THEM INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM

WHEREAS , it was found that these public facilities were necessary to meet the demands of the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Benchmark Land Company, the developer of these public facilities, agrees to dedicate these public works facilities to the City of Troutdale; and

WHEREAS, the construction of these public facilities has been completed; and

WHEREAS, City staff has inspected this project and found it to be in accordance with the Troutdale City Standards.

Total	369,089.50

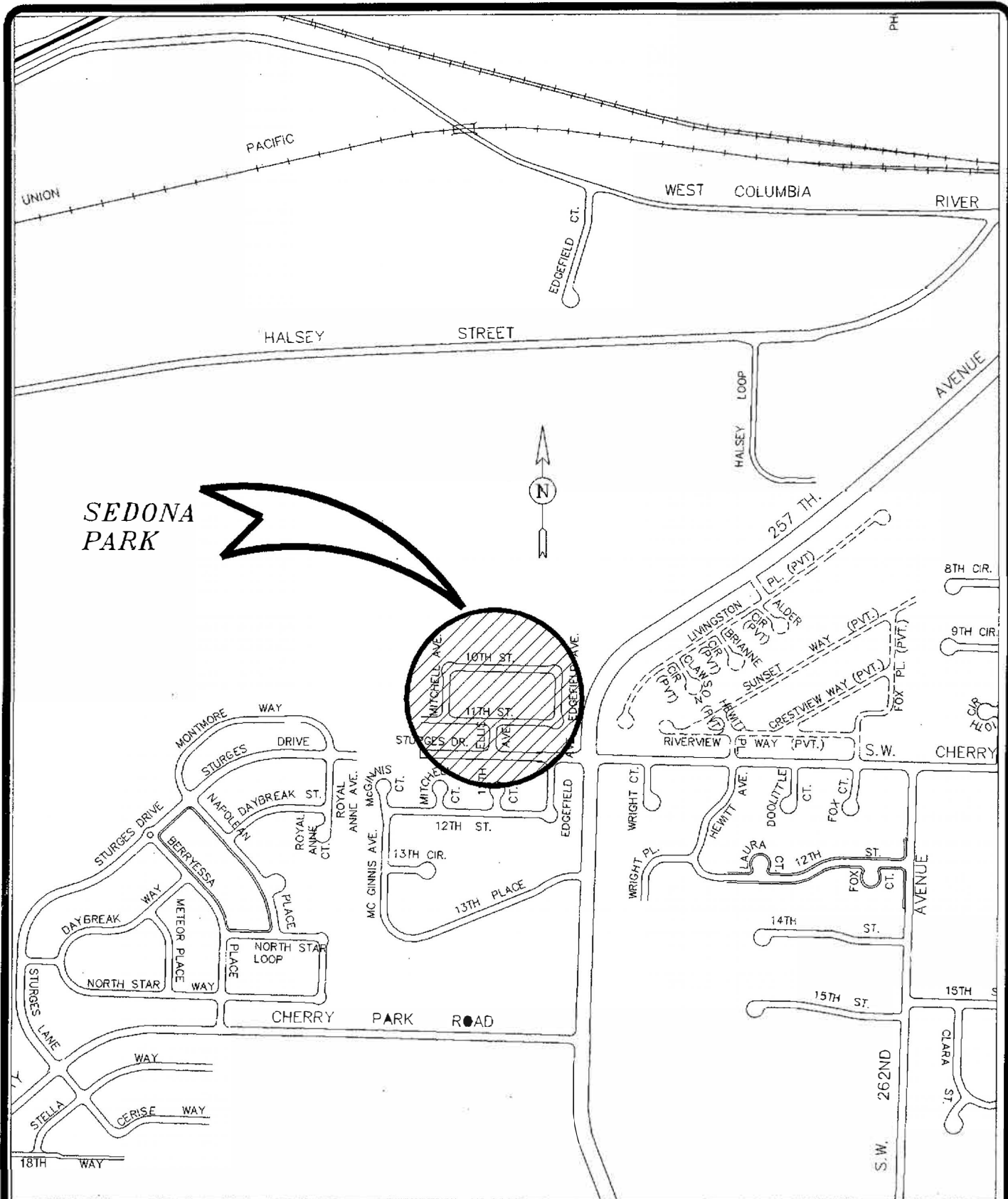

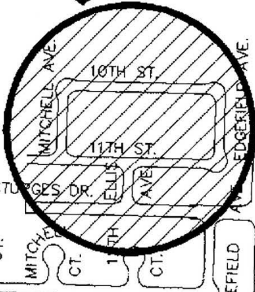
