

RESOLUTION NO. 1325

A RESOLUTION REVISING THE SANITARY SEWER UTILITY FEE AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 1036

WHEREAS, Section 12.04.030 of the Troutdale Municipal Code establishes a sanitary sewer utility fee and authorizes the Council to change the amount of the fee by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City has caused a study to be made concerning the alternatives for expanding its capacity to treat sanitary sewage; and

WHEREAS, an analysis has been made of the estimated costs to expand plant capacity and to operate and maintain the sewer system, as well as the anticipated revenues which can be applied against those costs; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the sanitary sewer utility fees proposed are necessary to meet the financial needs of the sanitary sewer system.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The monthly sanitary sewer utility fee per equivalent residential unit shall be as follows:

<u>Effective Date</u>	<u>Amount</u>
July 1, 1997	\$ 20.75
July 1, 1998	\$ 22.75
July 1, 1999	\$ 24.75

Section 2. An equivalent residential unit has a flow of 98,500 gallons per year with a biochemical oxygen demand (BOD) concentration of 180 milligrams per liter and a suspended solids concentration of 239 milligrams per liter, which shall constitute normal domestic wastewater.

Section 3. When a discharge exceeds the concentrations given above, a surcharge in addition to the monthly sanitary sewer utility fee may be imposed. The surcharge rate shall be \$0.026 per pound of BOD and \$0.028 per pound of suspended solids.

Section 4. Resolution No. 1036 is rescinded effective July 1, 1997.
