

RESOLUTION NO. 1381

A RESOLUTION RE-DESIGNATING \$90,000.00 FROM METRO LOCAL SHARE BEAVER CREEK RESTORATION FUNDS TO TRAIL IMPROVEMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, voters approved a \$135.6 million Open Space general obligation bond measure on May 16, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the Open Space measure provides a \$25 million pass-through to local parks providers as part of the \$135.6 million regional bond measure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale's share of this \$25 million pass-through is \$257,327; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale and METRO entered into an intergovernmental agreement (Contract No. 904601) to expend the pass-through funds for certain listed projects; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Division has expended \$75,000.00 in Beaver Creek restoration by way of grants from METRO and State; and

WHEREAS, the Park Division has scheduled \$30,000.00 for another creek restoration in the Fall of 1998; and

WHEREAS, the proposed modifications were referred to the city's Park Advisory Board at its meeting on May 19, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that a public process identical to the process used to select the initial sites was used to recommend the modification; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

\$90,000.00 of the City's METRO Greenspaces local share funds be re-designated from Beaver Creek Restoration to Trail Improvement.
