

RESOLUTION NO. 1392

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER TO SIGN SUPPLEMENT NO. 11 TO AGREEMENT NO. 30129-87 WITH MULTNOMAH COUNTY FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE.

WHEREAS, Multnomah County utilizes economy of scale to obtain personnel, equipment, and contracts for road maintenance at favorable costs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale has a need for certain road maintenance services available from Multnomah County; and


WHEREAS, the City and the County entered into Agreement No. 30129-87 for road maintenance services dated July 1, 1987, and have extended it by supplement annually thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue this mutually-beneficial relationship by extending the Agreement to June 30, 1999, by signing Supplement No. 11.

That the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized to sign Supplement No. 11 to the Road Maintenance Agreement No. 30129-87 with Multnomah County, extending it until June 30, 1999.




The Agreement by its terms expires on June 30, 1998.

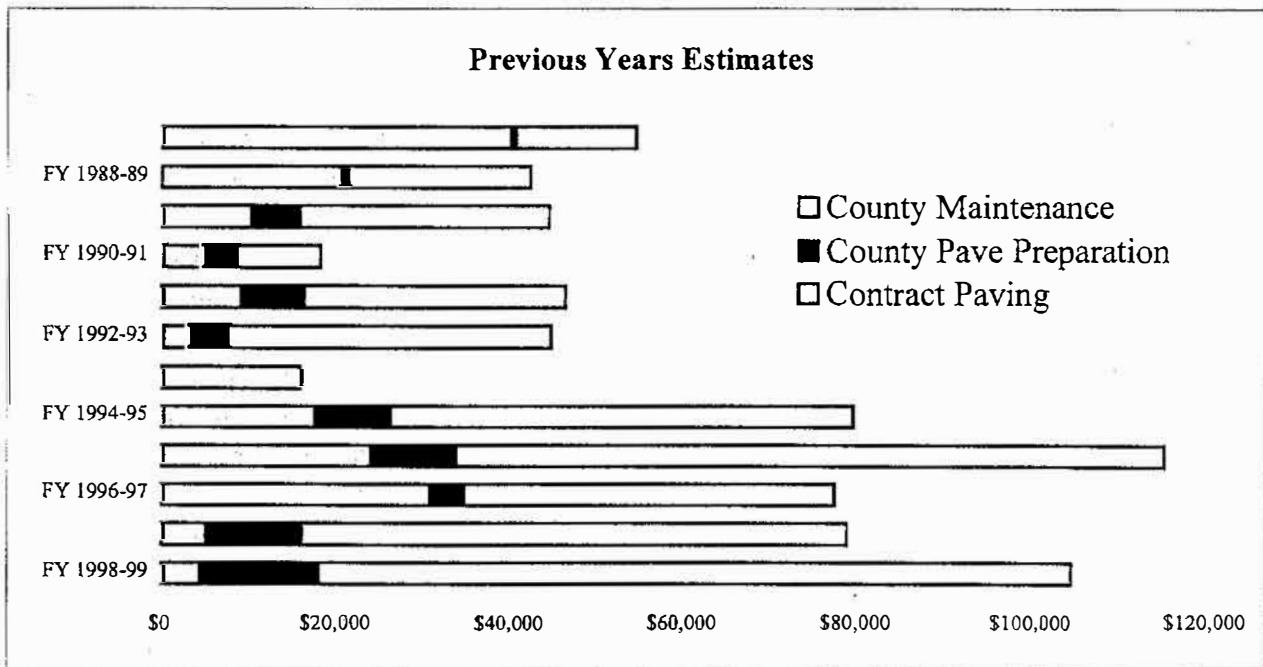

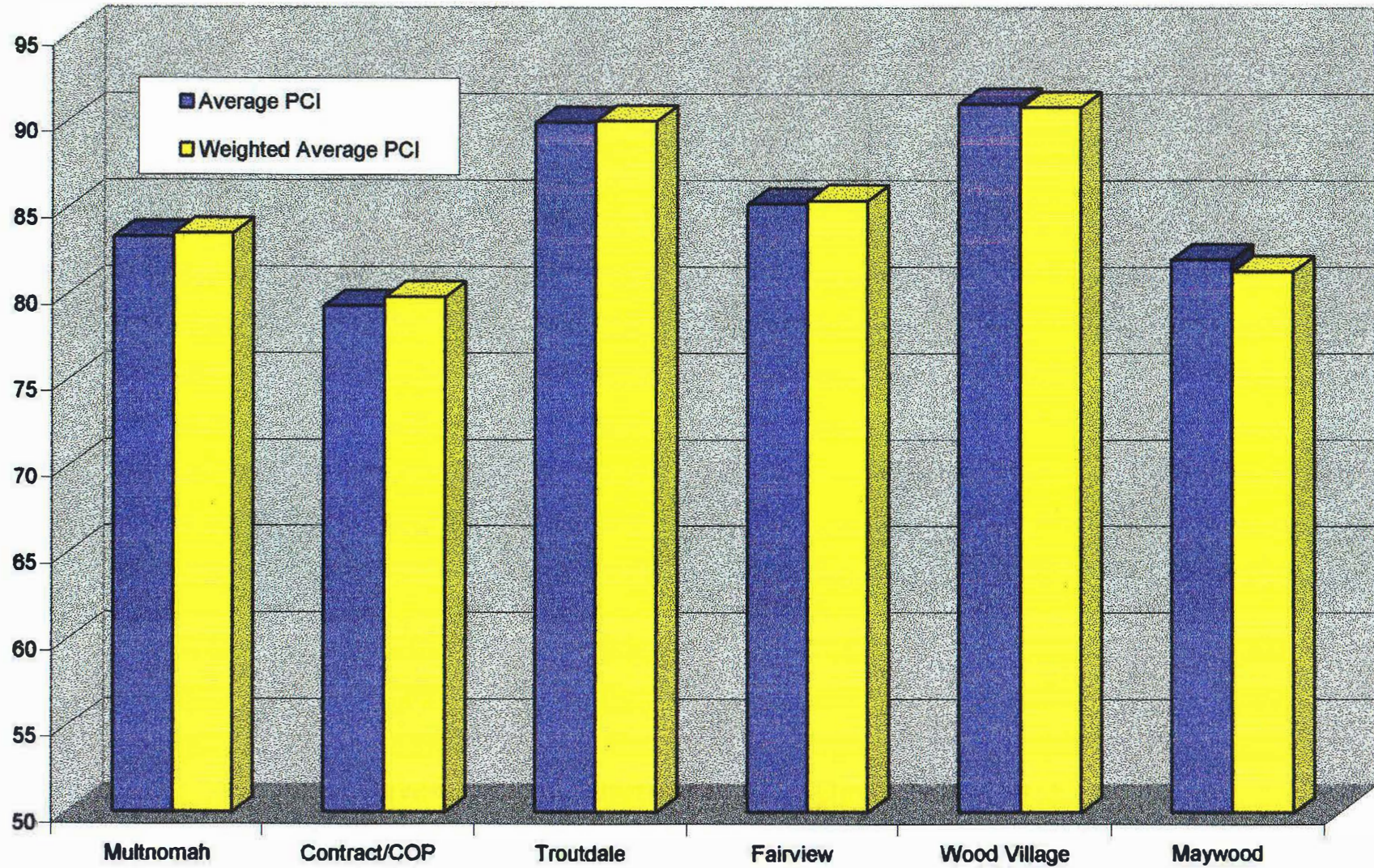

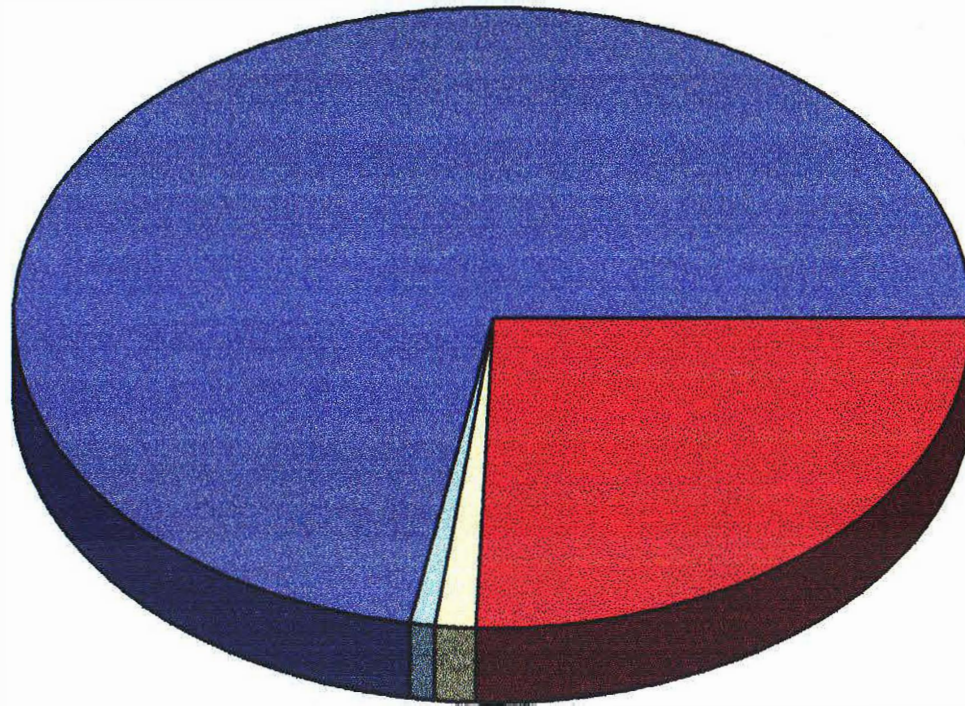
