

**RESOLUTION NO. 1413**

**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE 12-INCH WATER MAIN RELOCATION, ASSOCIATED WITH THE I-84 RAILROAD BRIDGE AND HIGHWAY WIDENING, AND ACCEPTING THIS WATER MAIN INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM.**

**WHEREAS**, this 12-inch ductile iron water main replacement and relocation was triggered by the improvements proposed by the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) as part of the I-84 Highway Widening; and

**WHEREAS**, replacing and relocating this 12-inch ductile iron water main was done for the best interest, benefit and welfare of the citizens of the City of Troutdale; and

**WHEREAS**, this 12-inch water main exists inside the Union Pacific Railroad's (UPRR) right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, by way of a written agreement previously entered into by the City and the UPRR, the UPRR has granted the City of Troutdale permission to be inside its right-of-way with this water main indefinitely; and

**WHEREAS**, this water main is also found inside the property of Joanne Maurine Connell, located at 2077 Historic West Columbia River Highway in Troutdale, Oregon, County of Multnomah; and

**WHEREAS**, the portion of the water main existing inside Mrs. Connell's property is within a public access and water utility easement (PUE) dedicated to the City of Troutdale by said property owner; and

**WHEREAS**, such PUE gives the maintenance crews of the City of Troutdale the legal and permanent right to ingress/egress these premises to maintain, own and operate this water main; and

**WHEREAS**, during installation, this 12-inch water main was inspected by qualified personnel from the ODOT and the City of Troutdale and was found to be installed in accordance to the applicable standards set forth by the American Water Works Association, the Oregon State Health Department, the City of Troutdale Standards and the construction plans and specifications.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE**

That this 12-inch water main shown on the attached Exhibit Map be accepted into the City's fixed asset system. This water system is valued as follows:

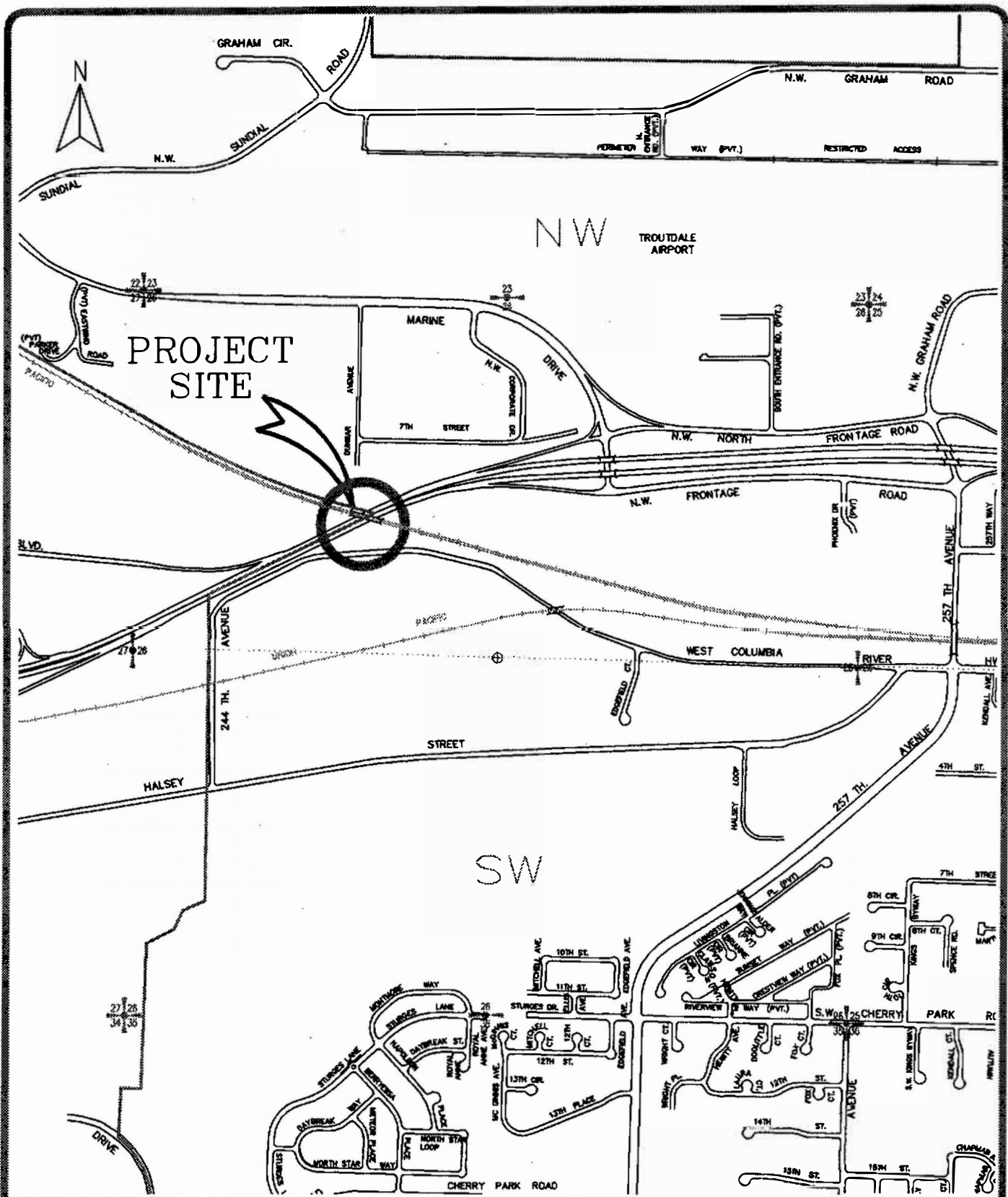
COLUMBIA RIVER HWY TO TROUTDALE
