A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SE SANDY AVENUE PEDESTRIAN AND STORM DRAINAGE PROJECT AND ACCEPTING THEM INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM

WHEREAS, it was found that the construction of the public works facilities associated with the SE Sandy Avenue Pedestrian and Storm Drainage project was necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the construction of these improvements has been completed and inspected by City staff; and


WHEREAS, these public facilities were found to be in accordance with the plans and specifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE


That the capital improvements associated with the SE Sandy Avenue Pedestrian and Storm Drainage project, including SE Sandy Avenue between SE 7th Street and SE 3rd Street and SE 3rd Street between SE Sandy Avenue and SE Harlow Avenue, consisting of the following facilities, are accepted into the City's fixed asset system:

114 Tons of asphalt-pavement street valued at	\$7,430
831 SY of sidewalk valued at	\$21,556
1,496 LF of straight curb valued at	\$11,968
285 LF of extruded curb valued at	\$2,280
1,550 LF of storm main valued at	\$37,200
7 storm drain junction boxes valued at	\$4,375
7 catch basins valued at	\$7,000
140 CY of gravity block retaining wall valued at	\$69,278
Grand Total	\$161,087

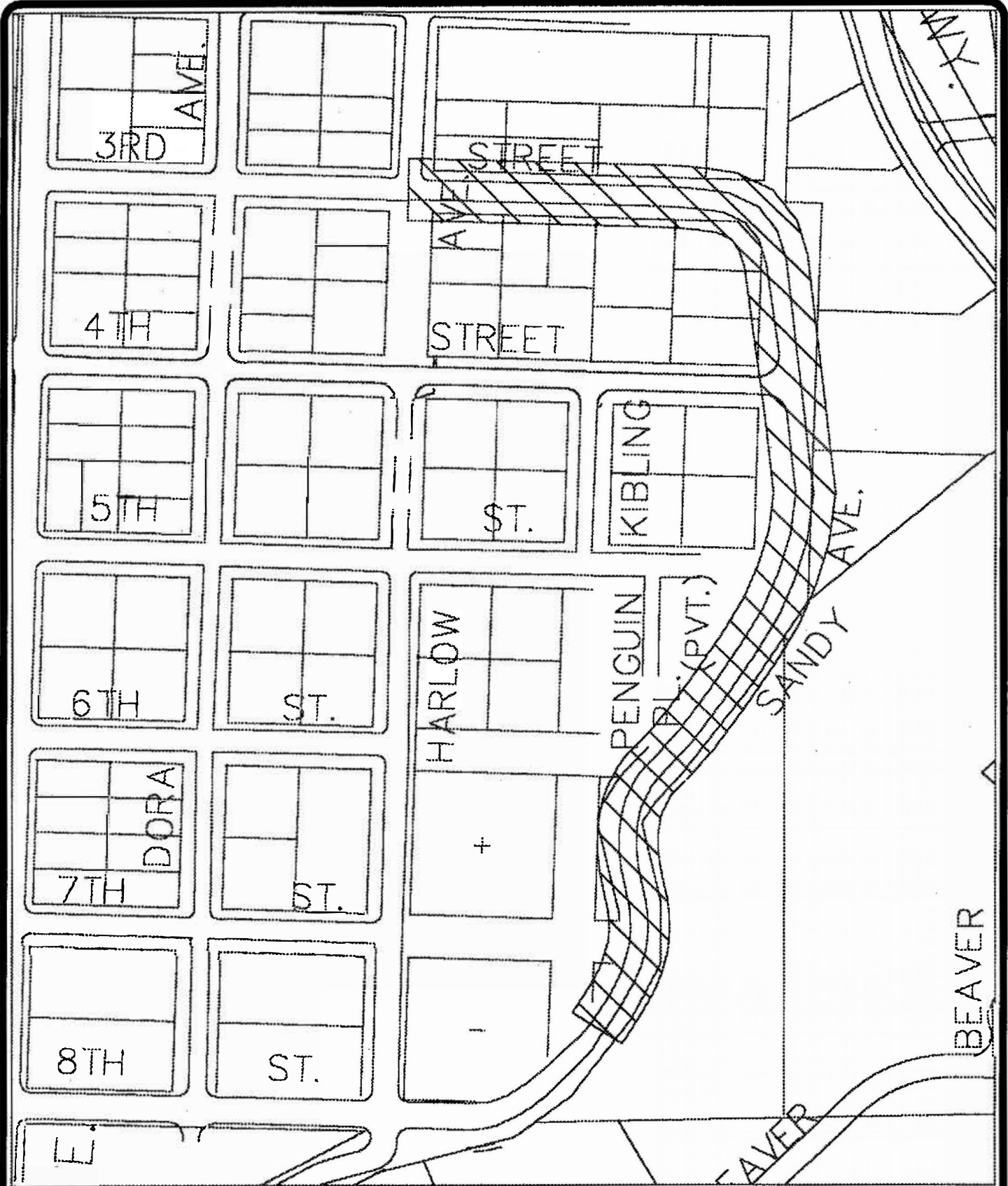
