

RESOLUTION NO. 1432

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE STARK STREET PRV RELOCATION PROJECT AND ACCEPTING THEM INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The construction of the public works facilities associated with the Stark Street PRV Relocation project was necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety and welfare.
2. The relocation of this PRV was the most cost efficient and functionally efficient method of creating new pressure zone boundaries required to support the future addition of Reservoir #5.
3. It was prudent to install 300' of new water line, required to connect Reservoir #5, concurrently with the PRV installation in order to avoid [in the future] damaging upcoming Multnomah County improvements to the Stark Street / Troutdale Road intersection.
4. The construction of these improvements has been completed and inspected by City staff.
5. These public facilities were found to be in accordance with the project plans and specifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

That the capital improvements associated with the Stark Street PRV Relocation project, consisting of the following facilities, are accepted into the City's fixed asset system:

1 Pressure reducing vault, 300 LF of 12" ductile iron water main, associated valves and fittings and other appurtenances valued at \$66,806.87.
