A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE HARLOW AVENUE SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND ACCEPTING THEM INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The construction of the public works facilities associated with the Harlow Avenue Sidewalk Improvements project was necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety, and welfare; and
2. The construction of these improvements has been completed and inspected by City staff; and
3. These public facilities were found to be in accordance with the plans and specifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE


That the capital improvements associated with the Harlow Avenue Sidewalk Improvements project, consisting of the following facilities, are accepted into the City's fixed asset system:

166 SY of PCC sidewalk valued at	\$4,750.92
43 SY of PCC driveway approaches valued at	\$1,529.51
9.5 SY of PCC wheelchair ramp valued at	\$593.75
136 LF of keystone modular block retaining wall valued at	<u>\$6,204.25</u>
GRAND TOTAL	\$13,078.43
