

**RESOLUTION NO. 1524**

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR DISTURBING  
PAVEMENT WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY AND  
AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1443**

**THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The cutting, removal, or other disturbance of pavement within the public right-of-way lessens the appearance and longevity of such pavement.
2. Instances of cutting, removing, or otherwise disturbing pavement within the public right-of-way are expected to increase with the creation of additional telecommunications firms in response to the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
3. The City Council desires to establish a fee for such pavement disturbances so that the costs thereof are partially borne by the entity causing the disturbance.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF TROUTDALE**

That Resolution No. 1443 (A Resolution Establishing and Revising Specific Fees and Charges) is amended to add the following Paragraph 6K:

6.K Pavement Disturbance Fee. Whenever the pavement (including street, bikeway, curb, gutter, sidewalk, or other paved area) in a public right-of-way is cut, removed, or otherwise disturbed by an entity other than the City, such entity shall pay a fee of \$ 0.53 per square foot of disturbed pavement. The revenue obtained from this fee shall be deposited in the Street Fund.
