

RESOLUTION NO. 1546

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE 257TH AVENUE
PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FOR THE FY 2004 AND 2005
MTIP PROJECT LIST**

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In 1997, the City of Troutdale applied for and received a grant from the Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) Program, a joint program of the Oregon Department of Transportation and the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development, to study improvements needed to enhance pedestrian, bicycle, and transit uses along 257th Avenue from the Historic Columbia River Highway to Stark Street.
2. The study was conducted, under the oversight of City and County staff, by a team of consultants and included a Citizen Task Force, a Technical Advisory Committee, a household survey, an open house, and a series of presentations. The study, which recommended a number of improvements, was accepted by the City Council on June 24, 1997.
3. Upon acceptance of the study by the City Council, the recommended improvements were submitted to Multnomah County for placement in the County Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).
4. Metro has solicited a limited number of new projects for the FY 2004-05 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Plan (MTIP), and the East Multnomah County Transportation Committee has recommended submission of the 257th Avenue Pedestrian Improvements Project.
5. Following a public hearing on March 27, 2001, the Troutdale City Council confirmed its intent to submit this project.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
TROUTDALE**

That the City Council authorizes the submission of the 257th Avenue Pedestrian Improvements project to Metro for the FY 2004 and 2005 MTIP Project List.
