

RESOLUTION NO. 1576

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF SANITARY AND STORM SEWER MAINS ASSOCIATED WITH THE NEW THRIFTWAY PLAZA EXPANSION (COMMONLY KNOWN AS TROUTDALE MARKET CENTER) AND ACCEPTING THEM INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

The construction of sanitary and storm sewer mains for the Thriftway Plaza, commonly known as Troutdale Market Center, was necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety and welfare.

The construction of these public facilities has been completed.

These new improvements have been inspected by the Public Works Department and found in compliance with the Troutdale Construction Standards for Public Works Facilities, construction plans and specifications.

A "Certificate of Completion" has been issued to the Troutdale Market Center LLC.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE
