

**RESOLUTION NO. 1596**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN REYNOLDS SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF TROUTDALE FOR THE REYNOLDS HIGH SCHOOL PARKING ADDITION PROJECT**


**THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. The City of Troutdale ("City") and the Reynolds School District ("District") entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") dated February 13, 2002 to detail the responsibilities, compensation, and services of each party regarding the parking addition and other related improvements at Reynolds High School. This IGA was approved by the City Council by Resolution No. 1588.
2. After the IGA was approved, it was found that the widening of a portion of SW Imagination Way, a City street, to accommodate school buses using the new parking area would pass over an existing twelve-inch City water main. It was further determined that the distance between final grade of the widened street and the top of the existing water main was less than the three feet required by City standards.
3. The District's consulting engineer proposed, and the City staff concurred, that the most appropriate solution to this problem was to lower the water main to the required depth and to replace that portion of plastic pipe with ductile iron pipe.
4. Replacement of the older plastic pipe with new ductile iron pipe is an enhancement to the City's water system, for which the City is willing to partially compensate the District by paying for the cost of materials involved, but not more than \$7,500. This arrangement will be formalized by an amendment to the original IGA.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE**

That Amendment No. 1 to the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Reynolds School District and the City of Troutdale for the Reynolds High School Parking Addition Project, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is approved.

**Amendment No. 1 to Intergovernmental Agreement between Reynolds School District and the City of Troutdale for the Reynolds High School Parking Addition Project**

**RECITALS**

**Whereas**, the City and the District entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement dated February 13, 2002 (the "Agreement") to detail the responsibilities, compensation, and services of each party regarding the parking addition and related improvements at Reynolds High School; and

**Whereas**, after that date, it was found that there was insufficient cover between the widened SW Imagination Way (required by this project) and the existing twelve-inch plastic City water main at that location; and

**Whereas**, the District's consulting engineer proposed replacing a portion of the plastic water main with one made of ductile iron and placed at a lower depth to meet City standards; and


**Whereas**, the City will receive an enhancement to its water system by obtaining a newer pipe made of more durable material and therefore agrees to bear a portion of the cost of that new water line.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES DO MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**


1. Section I, Paragraph A, of the Agreement is amended to add the following subparagraph 5:
  5. Install a new ductile iron, Class 52, twelve-inch water main to replace the existing PVC (plastic) water main wherever three feet of cover is not available, a distance of approximately 200 feet.
2. Section IV of the Agreement is amended to add the following Paragraph C:
  - C. The City shall pay to the District the actual cost of materials (but not more than \$7,500) to replace a portion of PVC water main with ductile iron water main.
3. All other provisions of the Agreement remain unchanged.




