A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY AND ACCEPTING IT INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The construction of the Water Pollution Control Facility was necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety, and welfare.
2. The construction of the Water Pollution Control Facility has been completed and inspected by City staff and by the City's consulting engineer, CH2M Hill.
3. The construction of the Water Pollution Control Facility has been found to be in substantial compliance with the plans and specifications for the project.
