

RESOLUTION NO. 1732

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SE SANDY AVENUE SIDEWALK INFILL PROJECT AND ACCEPTING THEM INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The construction of the public improvements associated with the SE Sandy Avenue Sidewalk Infill project was necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety, and welfare.
2. The construction of these public improvements was completed and inspected by City staff.
3. These public facilities were found to be in accordance with the City of Troutdale "Construction Standards for Public Works Facilities" and the construction plans and specifications.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The following public improvements associated with the SE Sandy Avenue Sidewalk Infill project are accepted into the City's fixed asset system, valued as follows:

<u>Improvement</u>	<u>Estimated Value</u>
New sidewalk and curb, consisting of approximately 492 SY of concrete sidewalk, 41 SY of concrete ADA ramps, and 967 linear feet of concrete curb.	\$25,900
New storm water collection system, consisting of approximately 153 linear feet of 12" ADS storm sewer pipe and 2 catch basins.	9,900
Total:	35,800


Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.

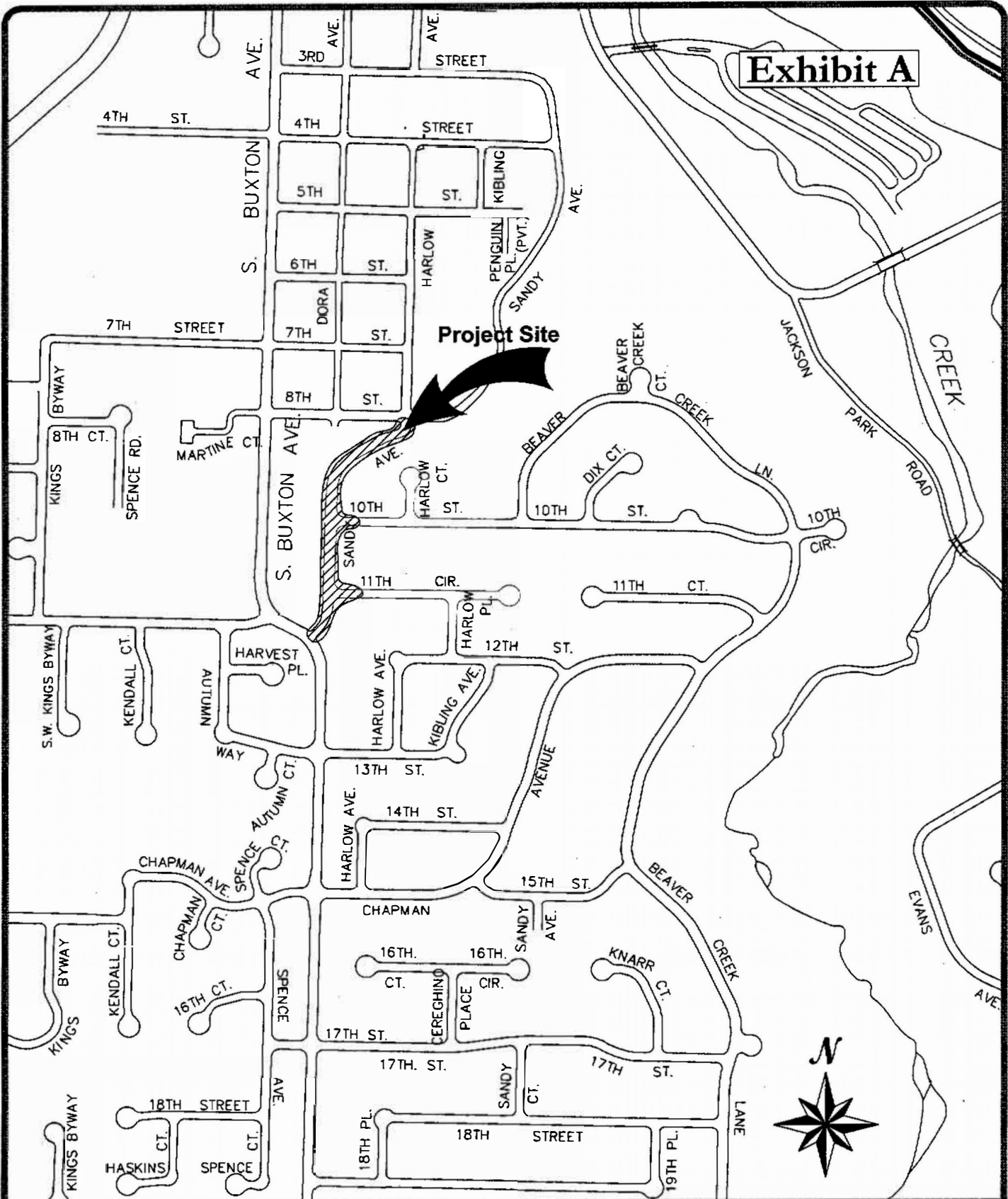
