

RESOLUTION NO. 1738

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITY OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, OREGON.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In order to qualify for accreditation of the Troutdale Police Department by the Oregon Accreditation Alliance, it is necessary to explicitly set forth in a Resolution the responsibilities and authority of the Troutdale Chief of Police.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:


Section 1. The Chief of Police shall establish written, and where possible, quantifiable and measurable goals and objectives based on policies transmitted to him by the City Administrator and shall be responsible for directing the administration and operation of the police department toward the achievement of these goals and objective through written policies, procedures and rules, and through personal leadership.


Section 2. The Chief of Police shall provide for an annual public review and evaluation of all department goals and objectives and progress made toward their achievement.

Section 3. The Chief of Police shall recommend to the City Administrator qualified persons for appointments to all vacant positions within the department other than his own, and the Chief of Police shall have the authority to suspend or dismiss any member of the police department subject to the approval of his action by the City Administrator.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
