

## RESOLUTION NO. 1775

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN RENEWAL NO. 18 TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 3012987 WITH MULTNOMAH COUNTY FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE.

#### THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:


1. Multnomah County's Transportation Division has certain equipment and employees with certain skills which the City does not have.
2. The City of Troutdale has a need for that equipment and those skills to perform road maintenance services.
3. The City and the County entered into Intergovernmental Agreement No. 3012987 for road maintenance services dated July 1, 1987, and have renewed it annually thereafter.
4. The City desires to continue this mutually-beneficial relationship by extending the Intergovernmental Agreement to June 30, 2006 by signing Renewal No. 18.


#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

AMENDMENT NO. 18**


This is a renewal of Intergovernmental Agreement No. 3012987 dated July 1, 1987, between Multnomah County and the City of Troutdale.


