

RESOLUTION #1787

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING USE OF ALCOHOL BY GROUPS RENTING THE SAM COX BUILDING.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The consumption of alcohol by groups renting the Sam Cox building has raised concerns about City liability and degradation of the facility.
2. The Parks Advisory Committee has recommended further study regarding alcohol consumption in conjunction with rental of the building.
3. There is need to prohibit the use of alcohol while these concerns are investigated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The Council hereby prohibits the use of alcohol at functions held within the Sax Cox Building.

Section 2. The Parks Advisory Committee shall further study the issues related to alcohol consumption within the Sam Cox Building and shall prepare a report and recommendation to the City Council upon the completion of that study. The prohibition on the use of alcohol within the Sam Cox Building shall remain in effect until the Council takes action on the Parks Advisory Committee's report and recommendation.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
